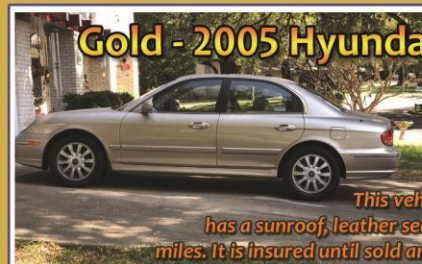

Presented by Dr. Elizabeth Peckham

Dr. Peckham now specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of Parkinson's disease, Parkinsonism, Essential tremor, Myoclonus, Tourette's syndrome/Tics, Ataxia, Dystonia, Restless Legs Syndrome (RLS), Huntington's disease, Tardive Dyskinesia, and Psychogenic movement disorders. She has extensive experience with the evaluation for and programming of deep brain stimulators and botulinum toxin injections.
